Can PROKON be installed in the C:\Program Files folder?

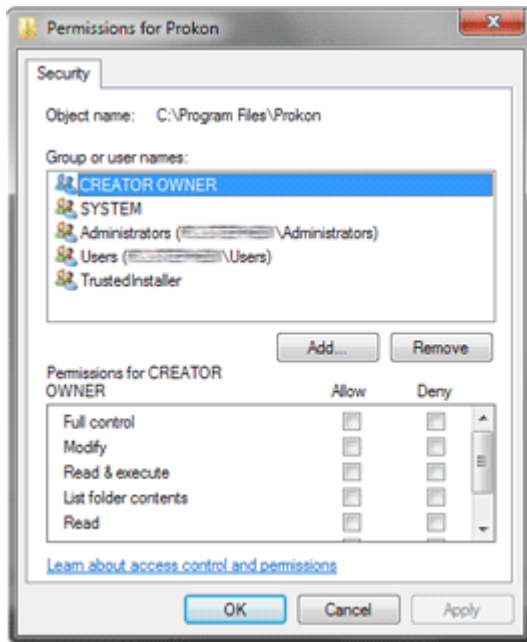
Security restrictions in Windows Vista and later complicate installation of **PROKON** in the C:\Program Files folder. However, **PROKON** should run fine if you make the changes in the folder permissions described below.

To function correctly, **PROKON** needs to be able to write and modify files in several sub-folders under the main Prokon folder, including User (storing of user preferences) and Prolock (managing of the program license). Windows treats the *Program Files* folder as a privileged location, and for that reason PROKON will not function there without making some adjustments.

Note: Less strict security policies apply elsewhere on your hard drive (outside of the *Program Files* folder). Therefore, we recommend you install **PROKON** in the default location, C:\Prokon, for the best experience.

If, for whatever reason, you want to install **PROKON** in Program Files, then you have to provide "full access" to the group "Users". The steps are as follows:

- Install **PROKON** to the C:\Program Files\Prokon folder.
- Open Windows Explorer. (Start Menu, All Programs, Accessories)
- Browse to the C:\Program Files folder.
- Right-click the *Prokon* folder, and choose Properties.
- View the Security tab.
- Select the Users group, and click the Edit button.
- Enable all permissions.
- Click OK to accept the new permission.
- Click Ok to close the dialogue box.
